Median Sales Price vs. Sales Volume

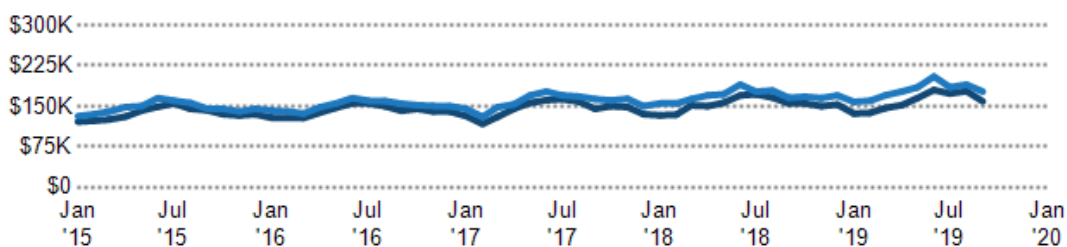
This chart compares the price trend and sales volume for homes in an area. Home prices typically follow sales volume, with a time lag, since sales activity is the driver behind price movements.

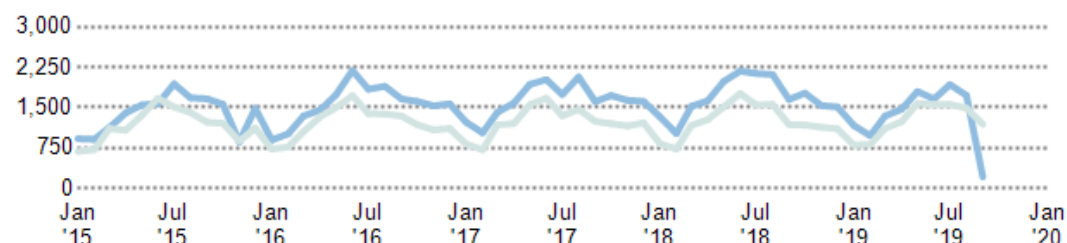

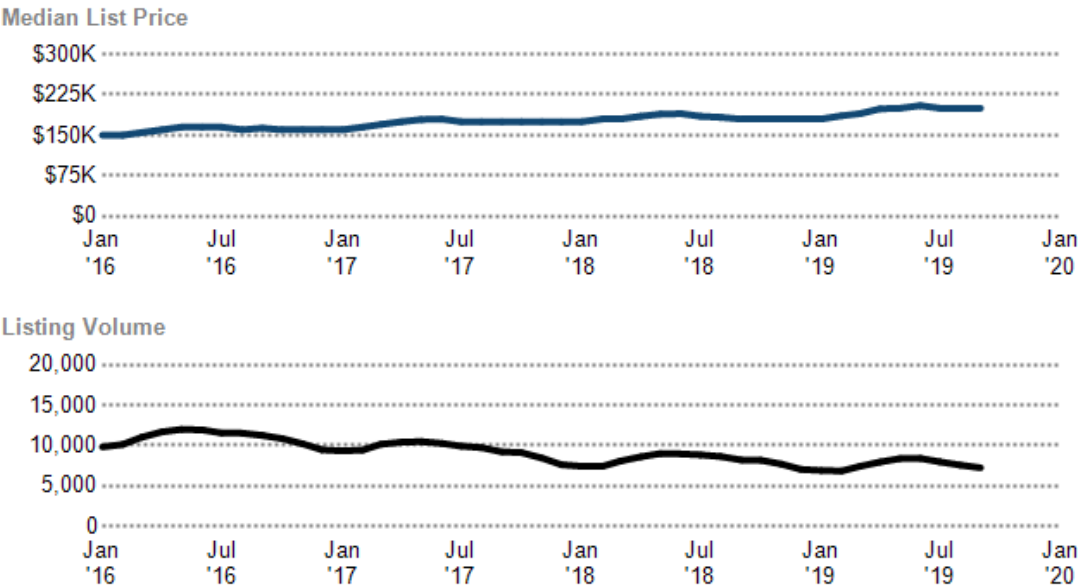
Median Listing Price vs. Listing Volume

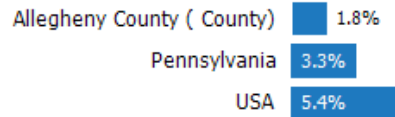
Education Levels of Population

This chart shows the educational achievement levels of adults in an area, compared with other geographies.

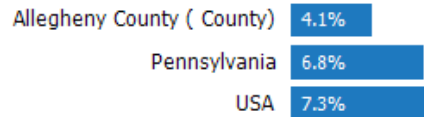

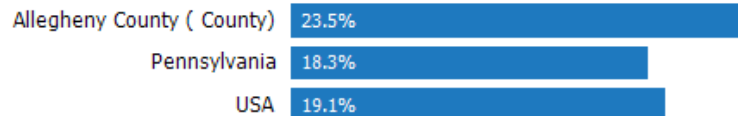

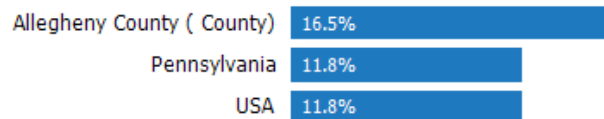

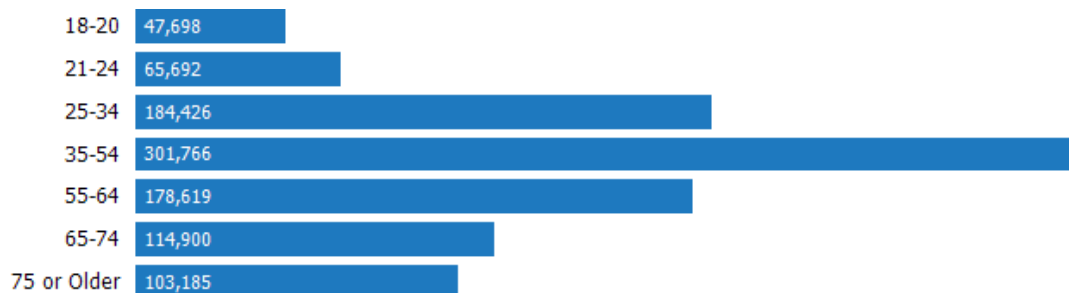
Population of Adults by Age Group

Median Sales Price vs. Unemployment

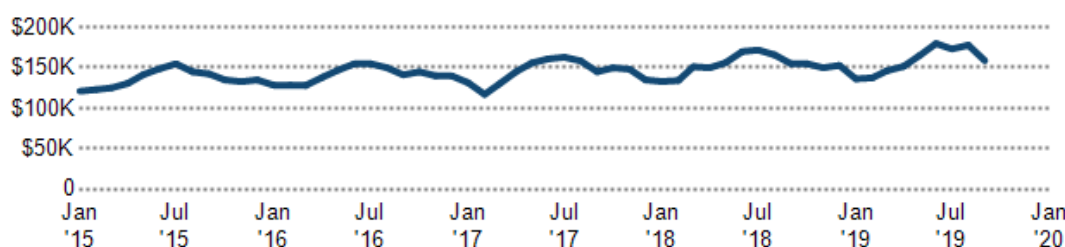

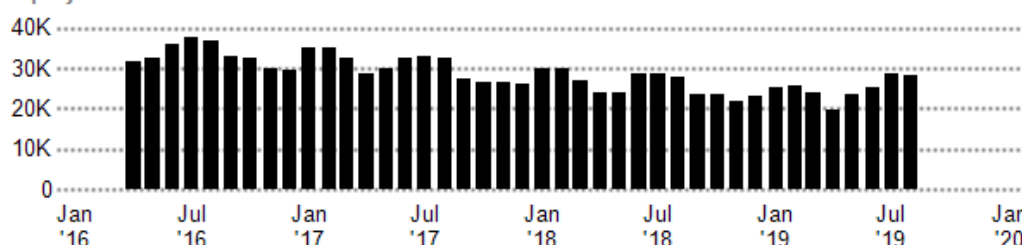

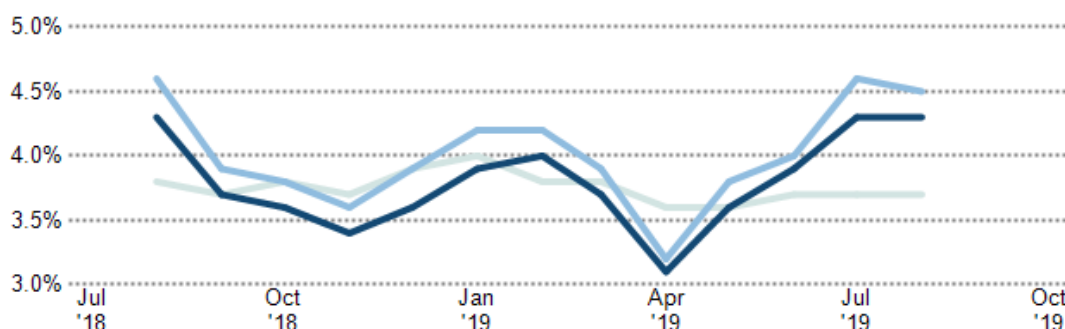
Unemployment Rate

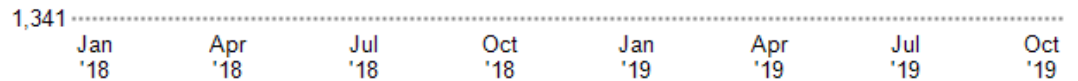
This chart shows the number of building permits in a county each quarter.

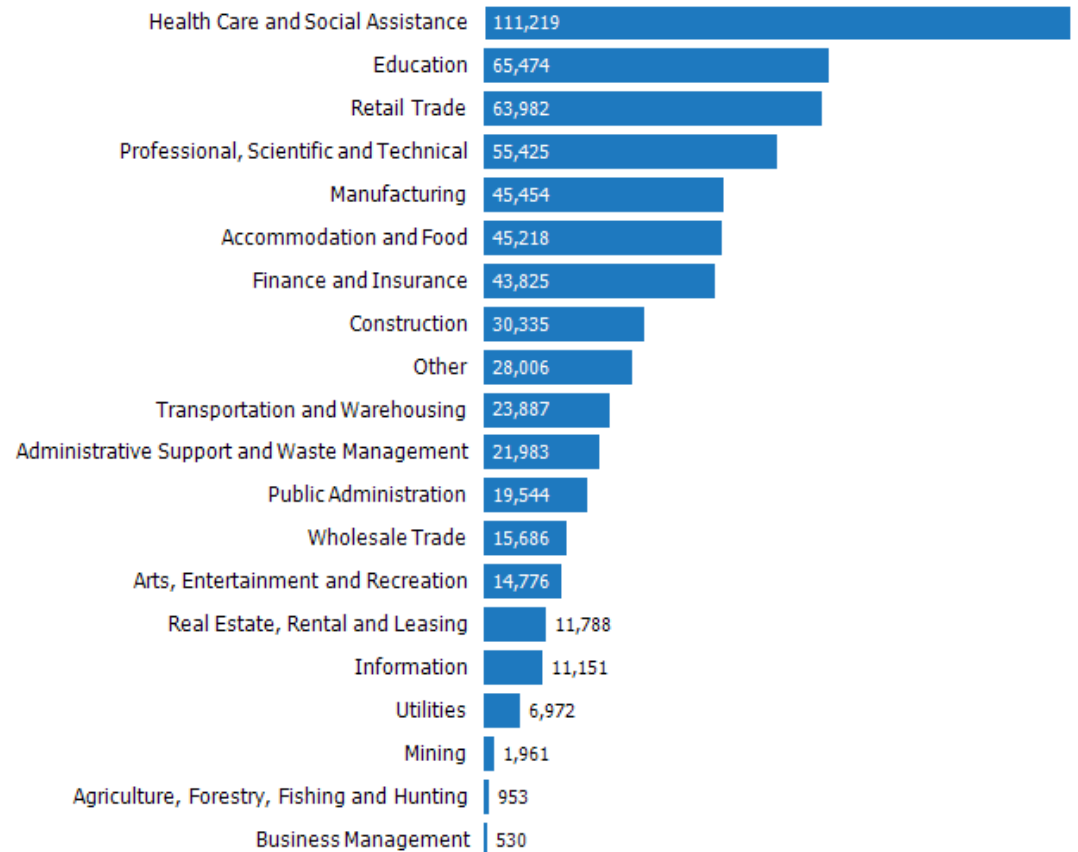
Occupational Categories

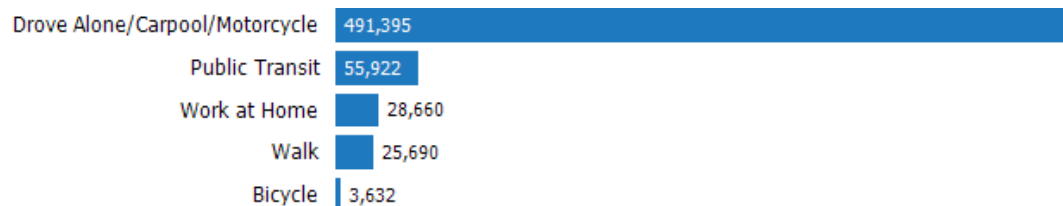


How People Get to Work
